Leadership Training Programs Camp Marston, Camp Surf & Raintree Ranch

We offer Leadership Programs at all of our camps throughout the summer. These programs were designed by campers to meet their needs and goals. They all offer opportunities to mentor and work with our staff and younger campers in a leadership role, but there is an emphasis on camp activities, opportunities for new experiences, and time spent with peers.

The Camp Assistant (CA) program is the final step and is an opportunity for campers who have completed the 2 week leadership programs (LIT or Soul Surfers), or who have demonstrated leadership through school, volunteer, or work experiences, to take on the challenges of leadership in camp. CA's make a 3 week commitment, and assist in a variety of camp program areas including sports, crafts, game leadership, evening programs, aquatics, horses at Raintree Ranch or day camp at Camp Surf. They are also role models for younger campers.

The CA program is a competitive volunteer experience for those teens entering 12th grade and they must apply and interview for placement. They must be responsible, dependable, and self-motivated. They should have either completed our leadership program or demonstrate proof of similar training and experience. Although supervised by camp staff, CA's must be able to work successfully as individuals and as part of a group. There is no charge for the CA program.

Who should apply?

The CA program is designed to build skills and provide leadership opportunities for teens. However, we are looking for participants who want to be at camp, are responsible, energetic, positive, and motivated. They must be a good role model and capable of working with diverse children in a positive and supportive manner.

Applicants for the CA Program: DO NOT fill out a camp registration form. Return this completed CA application and signed Code of Conduct to the camp where you would like to apply.

Applications accepted January 1-February 28.

Camp Assistant Code of Conduct

- 1. CAs shall be a positive role model for youth by maintaining an attitude of caring, honesty, respect and responsibility.
- 2. CAs shall use positive techniques of guidance, including redirection, positive reinforcement and encouragement rather than competition, comparison and criticism.
- CAs should be aware of the health of children and tell the nurse or program director if something is noticed.
- CAs shall respond to children with respect and consideration and treat all children equally regardless of sex, sexuality, race, religion or culture.
- CAs shall appear clean, neat and appropriately attired.
- CAs shall respect all children's right to not be touched in ways that make them feel uncomfortable and their right to say no.
- 7. CAs shall not abuse children including: physical injury (strike, spank, slap); verbal abuse (humiliate, degrade, threaten); sexual abuse (inappropriate touch or verbal exchange); unjustifiable punishment (shaming, cruelty); neglect (withholding food, water).
- 8. Any type of abuse will not be tolerated and may be cause for immediate dismissal from camp.
- 9. CAs should never put themselves in a position where they are alone with a child.
- 10. No child, regardless of age, should ever enter a bathroom alone in camp or on a field trip.
- Using, possessing, or being under the influence of any tobacco products (including vapes), alcohol, marijuana or illegal drugs is prohibited.

- 12. Profanity, inappropriate jokes, sharing of intimate details of one's personal life, and any kind of harassment is prohibited.
- 13. CAs shall refrain from intimate displays of affection towards others. Personal relationships beyond friendship are not appropriate at camp.
- 14. CAs must be supervised by a staff member at all times.
- 15. CAs are required to report observed violations of the Code of Conduct to the Summer Director.
- 16. CAs will not be able to leave camp other than with a parent or legal guardian.
- 17. At no time will CAs be with staff members during activities unrelated to camp or outside of camp unless it is an organized camp trip with appropriate staff supervision.
- 18. CAs are to remain on Camp for the duration of their stay at Camp Surf, Marston, or Raintree.
- 19. CAs will not be permitted to drive, or have a vehicle at Camp without a note from parent/guardian on file with Program Director.
- 20. Auto keys must be handed in to Program Director upon arrival. They will be returned at departure time.
- 21. CAs will be required to be in their bunks no later than 10:00 pm.
- 22. CA's and parents must understand that CAs are considered campers and at no time are to call themselves or solely play the role of a YMCA Staff member.
