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Dear Parents/Guardians,

This year we are holding a player-driven fundraiser for the Copley-Price Family YMCA Youth Basketball League, whereby all proceeds go back into supporting the league and scholarships for participants. The theme for this year's fundraiser is a league-wide shoot-a-thon! The shoot-a-thon will be held on Saturday, March 7, 2020 after regularly scheduled games take place. Please expect delays before and after games on that day.

Each player will be provided a fundraising packet with information, rules, and examples. There will be two types of donations preferred for this fundraiser, flat donations and donations per-basket (DPB). Players can accept either, or both types of donations, even from the same individual. Players are encouraged to fundraise from as many individuals as possible, thereby increasing their overall donation. Once the shoot-a-thon is complete and the totals are tallied, donations will need to be collected and turned in by the following game day (Saturday, March 14).

It is worth noting, that depending on a shooter's ability, donations per-basket (DPB) can add up quickly. If an individual elects to donate \$5 per-basket, a good shooter could use that to raise \$100+. While the DPB keeps this more exciting, please be sure to make the donors aware of their potential donation amounts.
