State Updates Order to Include Child Care

Updated details specifies the following statement regarding child care for essential infrastructure workers:

“Workers supporting public and private childcare establishments, pre-K establishments, K-12 schools, colleges, and universities for purposes of distance learning, provision of school meals, or care and supervision of minors to support essential workforce across all sectors.”

The California State Public Health Officer and Director of the California Department of Public Health have updated the list of Essential Critical Infrastructure Workers who are not subject to the Order to stay at home or in their place of residence.
